ANZAC DAY MARCH OPERATIONAL ORDER 2018.**



The ANZAC DAY Reunion will be held in The Elizabeth Room at The Sir Stamford at Circular Quay, 93 Macquarie Street. Members should be at our FUP no later than 1015 hrs. The marshals will move Units forwards as other Units vacate their Form Up positions. We do not know what time this will take place. The March Start Line for the march is on the corner of Elizabeth Street and Martin Place. The route we will take to the March Start Line will be from Spring Street into Bent Street, along Phillip Street and then into Elizabeth Street. If we have moved off by the time you arrive at our FUP, follow this route until you catch up or go straight to the March Start Line and join us there. If you feel you will have trouble walking up Bent Street meet us at Chifley Square.

Don McNeice has arranged 12 seats for those members who are unable to march and for one carer. The seating is on the corner of Elizabeth Street and St James Road. Contact Don McNeice 9524 5506 to make arrangements for a seat if still available.
Note: Only our members are to march with the Association or friends who have been in the Services.

- FUP and Time: Spring Street between Gresham and Pitt Streets no later than 1015 hrs.
- SO's for Dress: Suit, Navy Blue Blazer or Sports Coat, White Shirt, Regimental Tie, Kilt, Lovat Green Hose, Black Shoes, Balmoral or Glengarries.
- Medals: Authorized medals only are worn on the left breast. Deceased parent's/relatives medals and commemorative medals may be worn on the right breast.
- Massed Pipe Bands: Form up in Park Street (to the west of Elizabeth Street) facing East behind the Massed Pipe Bands as soon as the March is completed. The Massed Band will march along Elizabeth Street and continue to Martin Place where they will halt (remaining on Elizabeth) and The Massed Pipes and Drums will play the Lament 'Flowers of the Forest' in honour of Fallen and Departed Comrades. The parade will continue along Elizabeth Street and halt at Hunter Street to be dismissed. At the completion of the Ceremony, proceed down Macquarie Street to the Sir Stamford for the Reunion.
- Sir Stamford: Commences 1400 hrs in the Elizabeth Room, Sir Stamford 93 Macquarie Street Sydney.
- Reunion Lunch: It will be a three course sit down lunch costing \$65 per person. Thanks to the donations of two of our members some free drinks will be served during lunch for a limited time then it will be at members own cost. Drinks before lunch are at members own cost. Donations of prizes for our traditional raffle always very much appreciated appreciated.
